OPC Note:

** The Mormon Pioneer Overland Travel Records only cover journeys between 1846/7 and 1868. After 1868, there are no records documenting how emigrants travelled overland to Utah. Emigrants most likely used the new transcontinental railroad which was completed in 1869 and went through Utah.

William's cousin Worthy Naish put up the money for William and his family to emigrate. The loan was later repaid.
