Committed to Fisherton Gaol. Solomon Sutton alias Young, and George Waite, charged with having violently assaulted George Biggs and James Frances, on the turnpike road near Stert, and cut and stabbed the said George Biggs with a knife or some other sharp instrument, doing him grievous bodily harm, and endangering his life. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 23 April 1827**

1846

For Trial William Stevens and Isaac Wiltshire, charged on suspicion with having feloniously set fire to a wheat stack, a stack of wheat straw, and a stack of barley straw, the property of George Cooke at Stert **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 16 April 1846**
