


World War I Casualty

Private Wallis Walter Prince

Private Leonard Victor Drew, Service No: 10969; Date of Death 20th October 1915, aged 22.; No 4 Company, 2nd Battalion Coldstream Guards. Buried at Lillers Communal Cemetery, Grave ref: IV.D.6.

Son of Thomas and Ellen Drew, of Rose Cottage, Stert, Devizes, Wilts.

In the 1901 census at Trowbridge Road, Bradford on Avon the family are recorded as:-Thomas Drew, 31, a plate layer with the Great Western Railway, Ellen Drew, 29, and Leonard Drew, 7, born at Bradford on Avon.

He is commemorated in the Memorial Book at Salisbury Cathedral for Urchfont with Stert parish.
