



The Bapton Manor Shorthorn Sale

The sale of 103 head of pure-bred cattle from the well-known herd at Bapton Manor, Codford, Wilts, belonging to Mr J. Deane Willis, took place on Thursday last, and must be regarded as very successful. In all 88 cows and heifers averaged £29 each, and 15 bulls £35 15s. 5d., the average for the 103 head being £29 19s. 7d., and the total sum realized £3,088 1s. Among the purchasers were Mr. Tait, who bought for the Queen's herds at Windsor; Mr. P. L. Mills, president for the Shorthorn Society, who gave 110 guineas for Rose of Collynic, a noted prize-winning sow; Lord Moreton, Professor Baldassere and Mr. Hawkins, the two latter buying for Italy and Germany.
