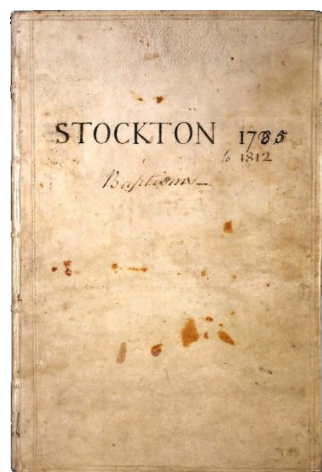


# Parish of Stockton
