




## *World War I Casualty*

### **Private William Waterman**

Private 11077 - A Company, 1st Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 27th February 1915 of wounds at No. 7 Loche Field Ambulance Station - Born in Godshill, Fordingbridge, Hampshire; Enlisted at Salisbury; Resident of Stratford Sub Castle Son of O.(Harry or Charles) and Annie Jane Waterman of Stratford Sub Castle; Prior to military service William was employed as a shepherd - Buried at Loker Churchyard, Loker, est-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference:- II. F. 9. - Commemorated on the St. Lawrence Church War Memorial, Stratford Sub Castle - Commemorated in the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral
