Boyle stated the facts, and said prisoner was drunk and behaved in a disorderly manner,- Prisoner called William Hannay, a man with whom prisoner resided, who said she was not drunk.- Supt. Robinson said prisoner was sent to gaol for assault in May last.- The bench fined prisoner 5s and 4s 6d costs.- in default 7 days imprisonment, she was allowed a week in which to pay.
