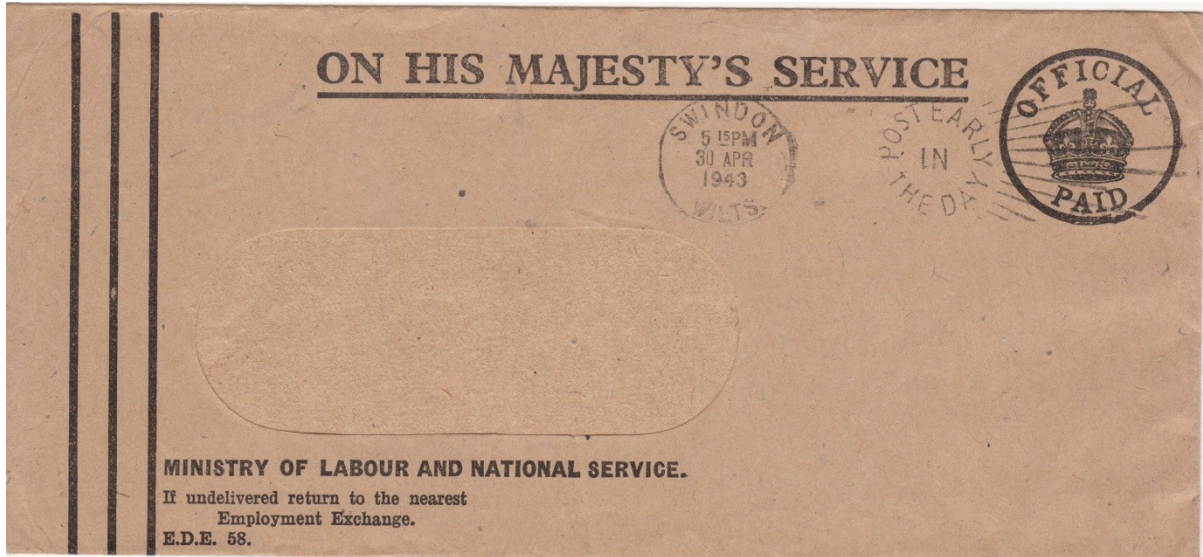


Civil Defence Posting Notice 1943

In pursuance of Regulation 29BA of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, I, the undersigned, a National Service Officer within the meaning of the said Regulations, do hereby direct you to enter the employment of the Swindon local authority as a part-time member of the Swindon Civil Defence First Aid Post Service.

NOTE 1.—Any person failing to comply with a direction under Regulation 29BA of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or to a fine not exceeding £100 or to both such imprisonment and such fine. There are heavier penalties for conviction on indictment.

NOTE 2.—Any person desiring to appeal for the withdrawal or modification of a direction on the ground that it would be an exceptional hardship to perform the duties required of him by virtue of the direction, may do so by making an application in writing to the National Service Officer. Such application must be made within four days of the giving of the direction. If such an application is made within the period stated, the direction to enrol will be regarded as suspended until a further communication is received from the National Service Officer.

NOTE 3.—A person directed to one of the following Services will not normally be required to do duty for more than 48 hours in each period of four weeks, but in emergency conditions he may be required to work longer hours :—
(a) part-time service in Civil Defence General Services;
(b) Police—as special constables;
(c) part-time service in the National Fire Service.
