



Death at Workhouse

William Fellows aged 82 has died at the Workhouse. He entered the big house about 7 years ago and remained there until his death. Deceased was a professional clarinet player a one-time member of Dan Godfrey's band, and had worked for some time on the continent. Described as a gruff old fellow with no known family and few friends. His wife pre-deceased him some years ago. He is buried at Stratton.
