William Horton

William Horton of Stratton St. Margaret was killed instantly when his horse galloped recklessly through Old Town and collided with a lamp post in Wood Street. His body was carried to the Kings Arms and the next day an inquest found that Horton had been "hot in liquor" after drinking heavily at a livestock auction at Shaw.
