



## The Wheatsheaf

**1700's - The Wheatsheaf**, 36 & 51 The Street, Lower Stratton. (158 Ermin Street) Stone built and tiled originally with attached cottage to south.

1834 Originally bought as a beer house by Richard White, it was leased to the Star Brewery for 1/- (5p) a week.

1867 Put up for sale, by Trustees of Mr Richard WHITE, bought by Arkell's. *Swindon Advertiser* 20-05-1867.

1936 William HERRING, 20, son of William Henry HERRING, landlord of the Wheatsheaf, Stratton, motor cyclist was killed in collision with a car at Calcot cross-roads near Nailsworth, Gloucestershire, on 30<sup>th</sup> October. *North Wilts Herald* 06-11-1936.

1937 An Emma Yeates was recorded as having died on the premises.

1941 Collect £2 1s 7d for War Comforts Funs. *North Wilts Herald* 24-10-1941.

1961 Obtained full licence.

1970 Modernised.

1979 Became Grade II listed.

2011 ex. Swindon footballer Paul Hunt took over the pub.
