## **USING THREATENING LANGUAGE**

Samuel Johnson, of Sutton Mandeville, was apprehended on a warrant for abusing and threatening John Gray, of Sutton Mandeville, on the 5<sup>th</sup> July last. Complainant said that the defendant stripped to fight him and abused him on the day in question, and also threatened to kill him. Johnson was bound by recognizance in 10 £ to keep the peace for six months.

## **PETTY SESSIONS - Hindon**

Henry Burt was brought up in custody, and bound over in his own recognisances in the sum of 10l., to keep the peace towards John Gray, of Sutton Mandeville, and all of Her Majesty's subjects, for six months.
