



CORONERS INQUESTS



Sutton Mandeville

Henry Thick

The following inquests have been held by Mr. George Sylvester: At Sutton Mandeville, on Henry Thick, aged three years, who was left in company with his brother, whilst their mother had gone to feed her pigs. During her absence, the clothes of the child became ignited, and so severely burnt him, that he died in about 24 hours. Verdict, "Accidental death."
