## **Bracher Monument**

(In the Churchyard – about 9 metres south of Porch of All Saints Church)

Located: Sutton Hill, Sutton Mandeville, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 27th July, 1985

Chest tomb. Early C18. Limestone. Plinth, two recessed panels to main sides, fielded corner and centre pilasters with rosettes and floral carving, end panels with skull and cross bones, cornice and pulvinated frieze with foliated carving, moulded flat top with raised panel. Robert Bracher died 1723.
