



Sutton Mandeville  
Mrs Mary Bracher  
Benefaction Plaque  
1848

By the Will of Mrs. Mary Bracher  
formerly of Panthurst in this parish  
bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup>. 1848. The sum of  
eighty pounds was invested in the names of  
the Rector, Churchwardens and Overseers  
of this Parish for the time being, the inter-  
est of the same to be expended yearly in the  
purchase of coal, to be distributed by them  
amongst the most Necessitous & Deserving  
of this Parish during the winter season.

**OPC Notes**

This is the Last Will and Testament of Mary Bracher, late of Panters in the Parish of Sutton Mandeville but now of Hindon both in the County of Wilts, Widow.

Set her hand 30 Dec 1848.

Codicil dated 18 June 1849.

Died 2 May 1851, aged 82 years.

Buried at All Saints, Sutton Mandeville, 8 May 1851, of Hindon.

Proved in London with a codicil 8 Dec 1851.

“Upon trust with and out of the same to pay to the Rector Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of Sutton Mandeville aforesaid for the time being the sum of Eighty pounds Sterling to be invested at Interest in the purchase of three per Centum Consolidated Bank Annuities in their names and I direct that such Interest shall be laid out yearly in the purchase of Coals to be distributed by them amongst the most necessitous and deserving poor of the said Parish of Sutton Mandeville in the Winter Season in such manner as they the Trustees for the time being think fit such last mentioned Legacy to be paid in procedure of the other pecuniary legacies hereby bequeathed out of such part of my personal Estate”.
