Knatchbull, Rector of Sutton Mandeville, in this county, was wholly destroyed, early on the morning of Saturday, the 9th inst., by a fire, supposed to have been the act of a cowardly incendiary. By this calamity a valuable horse belonging to the Rev gentleman was destroyed, and another was seriously injured. – *Salisbury Journal*
