Sutton Veny



Sutton Veny is a village and parish, close to Tytherington, in the Southern division of the county, hundred, union and county court district of Warminster, diocese and archdeaconry of Salisbury and rural deanery of Wylve, 3 miles south-east-by-south from Warminster station, 117 from London, and 2 south-west from Heytesbury,

The old church of St. Leonard, originally of Early English architecture, would probably date back to A.D. 1300, and consisted of nave, aisles and chancel; the tower contained 6 bells: the new church (St. John the Evangelist) is being built at the expense of Mrs Everett, and her son, Lieut.-Col. Everett, and the family; the foundation stone was laid May 29, 1866. The register dates from 1653. The living is a rectory, yearly value £800, with residence, in the gift of G. W. Heneage, Esq, and held by the Rev. G. F. S. Powell, B.A., of Wadham College, Oxford.

Here is a small Free school, also a place of worship for Independents.

The principal landowners are The Marquis of Bath, Lord Heytesbury, Sir Francis Astley, Bart., and Lieut.-Col. Everett.

The soil is sand and clay; subsoil, chalk and stone. The chief crops are wheat, oats and barley. The area is 3,580 acres, and the population in 1861 was 794.

NEWHAM is half a mile north-west; Hopping, a quarter of a mile south; Redding Hanging, 3 miles south.
