3 Long Monuments

About 24 Metres East of Church of St. Leonard

(Shown as 30, 31 & 32 on Map)

Location – Churchyard of St. Leonard about 24 Metres east of Church, Sutton Veny, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 1 July, 1986

Three chest tombs. Late C18 and early C19. Limestone.

All three of similar design; plinth, two plain inscription panels to main sides, fielded pilasters and moulded flat top.

North one has inscription to Frances Long died 1794, no legible inscriptions on other two tombs.

who Died June 16th 1806 Aged 18 Years.*

*Also of WILLIAM LONG Son of the said
WILLIAM FRANCIS and ANN LONG
who Died January 8th 1807 Aged 29 Years*

*Also of MARY LONG Daughter of
WILLIAM FRANCIS & ANN LONG who
Died September 23d 1809
Aged 25 Years*



To the left of the photo - 3 Body Tombs (shown on Map as 34, 35, 36) for:

Mary Long – wife of Francis Long

Francis & Stephen Long – Francis – died 18 Oct 1738 & Stephen died May 1798, son of Frances Long, aged 17 years

Francis Long – died 1761 – son of Francis & Mary Long, aged 27 years
