Dew Monument

in Churchyard of St. Leonard

Location – About 9 Metres North East of Church of St. Leonard, Sutton Veny, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 1 July, 1986

Chest tomb.

Ann Dew died 1687. Limestone. Two round-arched panels with dropped keystones, imposts and cable ornament to main sides and to end panels, fluted corner pilasters and cavetto-moulded flat top. An unusual design.
