In the Name of God Amen I Richard Hawkins of Sutton Veny in the County of Wilts Mariner belonging to the first Division being of sound and disposing Mind and Memory do hereby make this my last Will and Testament first and Principally I commend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God hoping for Remission of all my Sins through the Merits of Jesus Christ my blessed Saviour and Redeemer and my Body to the Earth or Sea as it shall Please God and as for such Worldly Estate and Effects as I shall be Possessed of or intitled unto at the time of my decease I give and bequeath the same as followeth that is to say I give and bequeath unto my beloved ffather John Hawkins of Sutton Veny in the County of Wilts Husbandman all such Wages Sum and Sums of Money as is or may now be hereafter due to me for my service or otherwise on Board any of his Majesty's Ships or any other Ship or Vessell and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved ffather sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament And I do give and bequeath unto my said Executor all the rest and Residue of my Estate whatsoever both real and Personal hereby revoking and making void all other all other and former Wills by me heretofore made and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty eighth day of December in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty seven and in the thirtieth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain ffrance and Ireland King Defender of the ffaith etc. *Richd Hawkins*
