

Post Office Directory Extract 1849 North Tidworth



North Tidworth, a small agricultural village in the Hundred of Amesbury, pleasantly situated 2 miles from the ancient town of Ludgershall, 15 from Salisbury, and 9 miles from Andover, in the adjoining county of Hants. The population is now 417, and comprises 2,725 acres of land.

The church is a small neat structure, with square tower. The living is a vicarage, annual value of £300, in the presentation of the Lord Chancellor; the incumbent is the Rev. Francis Dyson, M.A.
