



Inquest Report on William Coombes

Inquest

An inquest was held on Saturday, 5th January, before Mr. Cardell, deputy coroner, on the body of William Coombes, a labourer, aged 66 years, a native of Ansty, who was found dead on Friday morning in the parish of Wardour.

The Jury returned a verdict to the effect that the deceased died from exposure to the frosty weather.
