

The Countrys Loss

References to the death of the Queen were made at all the places of worship in Tisbury on Sunday. The Parish Church was draped in black, and at the close of the morning service the "Dead March" in Saul and Beethoven's "Funeral March" were played by the organist. At the end of the evening service the "Dead March" in Saul and Chopin's "Funeral March" were given, the congregation standing. At the latter service there was no organ accompaniment to the singing. It is expected that all shops will close until five o'clock on the day of the funeral.
