2nd Wiltshire Regiment; Sergeant, France. Killed December 3rd, 1917 at the age of 19 years.

ADLAM, THOMAS PRITCHARD

105, LOWER STUDLEY;

2nd Wiltshire Regiment, Private France. Killed March 12th, 1915, at Neuve Chappelle

ALFORD, GEORGE

19 SHAILS LANE.

Royal Engineers; Driver, France. Died August 27th, 1917, from disease contracted on service.

ANDREWS, JAMES

29 ISLINGTON.

1/4th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, India. Died at home from the effects of Malaria fever contracted on service.

ANDREWS, JAMES

21 ST THOMAS' ROAD.

5th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, Mons Star. France and Palestine. Wounded January 27th, 1915, at Nancy. Killed in relief of Kut, April, 1916.

ANGELL, F. H.

31 DRYNHAM ROAD.

Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France, killed on the Somme.

ATKINSON, ROBERT

15, YORK BUILDINGS, TIMBRELL STREET.

11th Suffolk Regiment; Private France and Belgium. Died from disease contracted on service, December 1919.

AVONS, WILLIAM

DYMOND SQUARE, HILPERTON.

1st Wiltshire Regiment; Private, Mons Star, France. Was reported missing in October 1914 and was found, through the British Red Cross Society, to have died of wounds whilst being carried to a dressing station after the Battle of the Aisne. He was in his 32nd year.

AYRES, ARTHUR JOHN

88 BRADFORD ROAD.

Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France. Was drafted to France in July 1916 and was killed in action April 9th 1917, at the age of 39 years.

BABER, PERCY

30 NEW ROAD.

Rifle Brigade; Private, Egypt and Salonica. Died in Salonica, December 5th, 1918.

BADEN, CHARLES WILLIAM

57 ISLINGTON.

2nd Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France. Killed October 18th 1916 on the Somme.

BAILEY, CLIFFORD

26, WYKE ROAD.

1st Wiltshire Regiment; Private; Mons Star. France. Missing since November 1914.

BAILEY, WILLIAM

15 WINGFIELD ROAD.

R.A.F.; Corporal, Home Service. Died in hospital on November 22nd, 1918, suffering from pneumonia.

BAKER, ALBERT EDWARD

1, HAWKINS BUILDINGS, HILPERTON ROAD.

1st Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France. Killed in action August 24th 1916, at Thiepval.

BAKER, VICTOR

7th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, Salonica and France. Killed October 15th 1918.

AVENUE ROAD.

3rd Wiltshire Regiment. Sergeant; 1914-15 Star, France. Wounded in the arm, August Bank Holiday, 1915. Died of pneumonia in Military Hospital in Kent, December 7th, 1918.

21 ST THOMAS' STREET.

2nd Welsh Regiment; Private, France. Died Prisoner of War April 17th, 1917, in Germany.

BARTHOLEMEW, FRED

SUN INN, CASTLE STREET

Royal Engineers, France. Killed May 28th, 1918 at Jonchery.

BAVERSTOCK, WILLIAM

10, Edinburgh Buildings, The Halve.

R.A.S.C.; Driver; Mons Star, Salonica. Died in Salonica, September 4th 1918

BEAVEN, HERBERT GEORGE

44 NEW ROAD.

15th Royal Scots; Lance Corporal, Mons Star, France. Wounded October 24th 1914 at La Bassee. Killed August 8th, 1917, at Arras.

BELBIN, ERNEST

25 INNOX ROAD.

Royal Engineers; Lance Corporal. France. Wounded June 26th, 1918. Died of wounds June 27th 1918. Buried at Pernois, France.

BELCHER, PHILIP STANLEY

76 PARK STREET.

Royal Engineers; Sergeant, 1914 Star, France. Killed July 10th, 1917 at Battle of Dunes, Nieuport.

BENDALL, WILLIAM GEORGE

52 ISLINGTON.

2nd Wiltshire Regiment; Sergeant, India, Africa, Gibraltar and France. Wounded at Festubert, May 1915. Killed on the Somme, October 18th, 1916.

BENNETT, JOSEPH WILLIAM

HORSE ROAD, HILPERTON.

Somerset Light Infantry; Private, France. Was killed in action on May 4th, 1916 at the age of 25 years.

BENNETT, WILLIAM CHARLES HECTOR

HORSE ROAD, HILPERTON.

15th Hampshire Regiment; Private, France. Killed September 5th 1918.

BETHELL, JAMES

10 Adcroft Street.

2/4 Wiltshire Regiment, Private. Died at Newcastle, March 7th, 1915.

BILLETT, S. H.

14 WYKE ROAD.

6th Wiltshire Regiment; Private. France. Wounded in arm in July and was killed September 1st, 1916

BISHOP, ALFRED CHARLES

16 DURSLEY ROAD.

4th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, Mesopotamia and India. Missing, April 6th, 1916, at Kut.

BISHOP, GEORGE WILLIAM

7 CASTLE STREET.

5th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, Mesopotamia. Wounded on March 29th and was conveyed to the base hospital at Basra where he died on May 11th 1917 at the age of 30 years.

BLAKE, GEORGE VICTOR

GLEBESIDE HOUSE, UNION STREET.

Shropshire Light Infantry; 2nd Lieutenant; France. Killed December 3rd, 1917 at Cambrai.

BLAKE, ROBERT

SALTERS YARD, COURT STREET.

1st Wiltshire Regiment; Private; Mons Star, France. Died of wounds received on the Aisne.

BOA, ANDREW

GLENMORE, 52 AVENUE ROAD.

Machine gun Corps., Private, France. Wounded January 5th, 1918, died in hospital at Passchendaele, February 1st., 1918.

BOND, CHARLES GORDON

Ormonde, Victoria Road.

Gazetted to the Wiltshire Regiment in 1900. Captain. Was killed while serving with the 2nd Battalion, November 25th, 1915. Was adjutant 4th Battalion when war broke out, and went to India with them in 1914.

BOX, REGINALD

89, LOWER STUDLEY

Middlesex Territorials Private, France. On joining the Colours he was passed for home duties, and was sent to London and other places for training, and improved so much that he was drafted to France in the latter part of September, where a fortnight later he was killed at the early age of 21 years.

BRAY, ALBERT

HORSE ROAD, HILPERTON MARSH.

Inniskillen Fusiliers; Private, France. Died whilst prisoner of war.

BRAY, CHARLES

23 TIMBRELL STREET.

Cheshire Regiment; Private, France. Served in the South African War and rejoined the colours at the outbreak of war, and was soon drafted to France, and was killed in action on June 10th, 1915 at the age of 35 years.

BRAY, RALPH RICHARD

19 MORTIMER STREET.

1/4th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, India, Egypt and Palestine. Died at Kantara Hospital, Egypt.

BRAY, WILLIAM

HORSE ROAD. HILPERTON MARSH.

2nd Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France. Killed in action on April 9th, 1917.

BRAY, WILLIAM CLEMENT

22 PROSPECT PLACE.

R.N. Seaman. After 20 days service on HMS Powerful was taken ill with pneumonia and emphysema and died on the 25th of November, 1918 at the age of 18 years.

BRITTAIN, WILLIAM GEORGE

1 Cox's Yard, Castle Street.

Royal Engineers, Sapper. Home Service. Died January 28th, 1919 at Sutton Veny Hospital.

BRUNKER, ALBERT

4 BRADFORD ROAD.

8th Royal Warwicks; Private, France. Killed August 27th, 1916 at the age of 21 years.

BURBIDGE, HENRY JOHN

39 THE HALVE.

Royal Marine Artillery; Bombardier, 1914 Star. North Sea. Died at sea, June 21st, 1915.

BURGE, WILLIAM

6 UPPER BROAD STREET.

Royal Engineers; Lance Corporal, France. Died at his home after discharge, July 8th, 1916.

BUSH, WILLIAM STANLEY

KING'S ARMS, CASTLE STREET.

R.F.A. Bombardier, France. Died at the 4th clearing station, France on November 21st, 1918, from the effects of pneumonia, and was buried at Solesmes, at the age of 24 years.

BUTCHER, FREDERICK

58 MORTIMER STREET.

R.N. Able Seaman. North Sea and Red Sea. Killed May 29th, 1916, in the Battle of Jutland, at the age of 18 years.

BUTCHER, HAROLD

58 MORTIMER STREET.

Royal Warwick Regiment; Private, France. Was severely wounded by shrapnel in the head, early in May and died at a general hospital in France on June 4th, 1917, at the age of 26 years.



75 NEWTOWN.

Somerset Light Infantry; Private, France. Drowned.

CARPENTER, THOMAS

75 NEWTOWN.

4th Dorset Regiment; Private, Mesopotamia. He was one of many who volunteered for service in the Persian Gulf, and went there in October 1916, was wounded on September 28th 1917 and succumbed after three weeks treatment in hospital in Baghdad on October 21st, 1917 at the age of 19 years.

CARR, ARTHUR HENRY

11 GLADSTONE ROAD.

Royal Engineers, Sapper, France. Killed July 31st, 1917.

CHAPPELL, HUBERT HOWARD

5 BOND STREET.

R.M.L.I. Private, France. Died from wounds received in action on March 27th 1918, buried at Hedanville.

CHIVERS, WILLIAM

19 Westbourne Road.

R.G.A.; Gunner, France. Wounded once. Killed somewhere in France.

CLARK, HAROLD CONQUEST

WYKE HOUSE, HILPERTON MARSH.

3rd Wiltshire Regiment, Captain; M.C. France. Was seriously wounded in the leg and thigh on February 5th, and died February 7th, 1918.

CLIFT, FREDERICK ALFRED

86 FROME ROAD.

1st Wiltshire Regiment; Lance Corporal, Egypt and France. Joined at the age of 16 years. Killed in action at his post with machine gun at Vaulx Francourt.

CLIFT, HERBERT REGINALD

19, Wyke Road.

5th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France, Egypt and Mesopotamia. Suffered with frost bitten feet in France. After recovery he was sent to Egypt where he saw much fighting, and from there to Mesopotamia where he was killed.

COLCOMBE, MONTAGUE

33 INNOX ROAD.

Royal Engineers; Lance Corporal, India and Mesopotamia. Died November 4th, 1918.

COTTLE, BERNARD NEWMAN

121 MORTIMER STREET.

2nd Wiltshire Regiment; Private, 1914-15 Star, France. Killed March 24th, 1918, at the age of 19 years.

T COX, LEONARD ARTHUR

17 GLADSTONE ROAD.

5th Wiltshire Regiment; Corporal, Gallipoli and Dardanelles. Wounded and missing August 10th, 1915. Notified presumed killed December 24th, 1916.

CROCKERTON, WILLIAM JOHN

IVANHOE, COCKHILL.

4th Wiltshire Regiment; Corporal, India and Mesopotamia. Captured by Turks. Died April 1919.

CROSS, THOMAS VICTOR

24 Wyke Road.

Royal Field Artillery; Gunner, France. Killed by shellfire on Sunday, June 20th, 1915, while at work at his gun at Le Brebis.

CULVERHOUSE, SAMUEL JOHN

48, BOND STREET.

R.A.S.C., Driver, France. Died March 30th, 1919 at Abbeville.

CUTMORE, JOHN

23 UNION STREET.

19th Canadian Regiment; Private, France. Killed August 8th, 1918, buried Crucifix Corner Cemetery, S.E. Corbie.
