R.E.; Sapper. France, Missing since March 1918.



**DAVIS, WILLIAM WALTER JOHN**

4 ALLEN ROAD.

R.F.A. Driver, France. Killed March 19th 1918, and was buried at Mendinghem near Poperinghe.



**DEVERALL, FREDERICK BLAKE**

11 WEST STREET.

K.R.R. Corps; Lance-Corporal, France. Died of wounds April 26th, 1917 at No 12 General Hospital Rouen.



**DOWDING. ALBERT EDWARD**

64 NEWTOWN.

R.A.S.C. Staff Sergeant; Mons Star and M.S.M. Died of pneumonia at Le Havre, November 4th, 1918. Mentioned in dispatches, 1917, by Sir Douglas Haig.

R.N.D. Private. Killed at Cambrai.

11 WEST STREET.

K.R.R. Corps; Lance-Corporal, France. Died of wounds April 26th, 1917 at No 12 General Hospital Rouen.

H.A. Company; Sergeant, France and Belgium. Killed by a shell on June 28th, 1917, at Bapaume, at the age of 21 years. Recommended for M.M.

1/8th, Royal Warwick Regiment; Lance-Corporal, France. Killed August 27th 1917 at St Julien, Ypres, at the age of 24 years.

1/4th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, India and Egypt. Killed May 10th, 1918. Buried at Ballut.

1st Warwick Regiment; Private. France. Killed October 1916.

1st Somerset Light Infantry; Private, Mons Star, France. Killed in Action in France, August 28th 1915, at the age of 27 years.
