





GARDINER, FRED

9 YERBURY STREET

48th Canadian Highlanders; bugler; France. He embarked for France on May 2nd, and was killed on May 20th, 1915 at Festubert, at the age of 35 years.



GAYTON, LESLIE

21 EASTBOURNE TERRACE.

1/4th Wiltshire Regiment, Private. India and Mesopotamia. Taken prisoner at Kut and died a prisoner of war.



GIBBS, ALBERT

2 NORTH VIEW COTTAGES, MORTIMER STREET

R.H.A.; Driver. Mons Star; in the famous 'L' Battery. Died at Rouen, November 1918.



GOMM, ERNEST ARTHUR

28 GLOUCESTER ROAD.

6th Wiltshire Regiment; Lance sergeant. France and Belgium. Drafted to France in September 1915, and escaped injury until December 26th, when he received a severe bullet wound from a sniper. He was conveyed to hospital where he died on January 2nd 1916 at the age of 22 years.



GOMM, STANLEY OLIVER

28 GLOUCESTER ROAD.

6th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France and Belgium. Died of wounds, January 1st, 1918



GORE, FREDERICK

24 THE HALVE

Rifle Brigade; Corporal. Mons Star, France. Whilst in France he took part in many heavy engagements and was twice severely wounded. He was killed in action on the Somme on August 17th, 1916 at the age of 24 years.



GOULDRIDGE, J. O.

CAPITAL AND COUNTIES BANK, FORE STREET.

Worcester Regiment; Lieutenant; France. Missing, presumed killed.

GRAY, BERTIE GEORGE

NEW COTTAGES, WHADDON

2nd Wiltshire Regiment. Died of wounds, May 9th 1917, at 16th General Hospital, Le Treport, at the age of 22 years.

GRIFFEN, ARTHUR FRANCIS

HORSE ROAD, HILPERTON MARSH

R.G.A. Gunner; France. Died of wounds, December 6th, 1917

GRIFFEN, GILBERT WILLIAM FRANK

39 WYKE ROAD.

1/5th South Lancashire Regiment, Private. France. Died of wounds received on May 20th, 1918, through the bursting of a shell, when returning to the trenches after a rest, at the age of 19 years.

GRIFFEN, SYDNEY HERBERT

8 ALLEN ROAD

Mercantile Marine; Able seaman. Mediterranean. Ship torpedoed, and he was drowned in Eastern Mediterranean on the 21st of January 1918, at the age of 19 years.

GRIFFEN, WILFRED JAMES FREDERICK

39 WYKE ROAD

M.G.C.; Private, France. Killed in action April 11th, 1918. He was shot through the neck with a machine gun bullet and killed instantly, at Ypres, at the age of 20 years.

GREEN, SIDNEY JAMES

15, GLADSTONE ROAD

7th Wiltshire Regiment; Private. Salonica and France. Wounded at Salonica. Died of wounds at Liverpool Hospital, November 23rd., 1916

GREENHILL, HERBERT

119 NEWTOWN

R. Canadians 'Princess Pat's Own'; Private. France. Killed in bombing attack at Cambrai.



GROVES, WILFRED FREDK. STANLEY

6 NEWTOWN

4th Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France. Wounded at Messines. Killed December 4th, 1917, at Ypres at the age of 19 years.



GULLIVER, JOHN

HORSE ROAD, HILPERTON MARSH

Wiltshire Regiment; Private. France. Died from disease contracted on service. November 1918.



HALL, WILLIAM

3 ST THOMAS' ROAD, THE HALVE

3rd Wiltshire Regiment; Private. France. Killed in the First Battle of Ypres.



HANCOCK, G.J.

19 HILPERTON ROAD

Canadian R.A.M.C.; Private. Died in hospital in Canada.



HARMAN, GEORGE HERBERT

32 DUKE STREET

16th London Regiment. Q.W.R; Rifleman, France. Killed April 8th, 1917 at the age of 21 years.



HARRIS, WILLIAM

56 BRADFORD ROAD

8th Wiltshire Regiment; Private. France. Reported missing since July 1917.



HARRISON, ALBERT

38 GLOUCESTER ROAD

2nd Gloucester Regiment; Corporal; South African Medal. France. He embarked for France in November and in January was invalided home with severe frostbite. After treatment in hospital and a short furlough he returned to France and took part in several severe engagements and was killed in action on May 9th, 1915, aged 35 years.

HARTLEY, SIDNEY PERCY

18 MIDDLE RANK.

1st Dorset Regiment; Private, France. Killed January 23rd, 1915 at Givenchy.

HATHERELL, B.

SHAILS LANE.

Hampshire Regiment, Lance Corporal; France and Egypt. Killed somewhere in Egypt.

HAWKINS, J.H.

2 ANSTIE'S COURT MORTIMER STREET

Royal Engineers; Corporal; Mons Star, France. Died of wounds, May 7th, 1917

HAWKINS, WILLIAM JAMES

23 INNOX ROAD

Australian I.F.; Private, France. Killed October 3rd, 1918 at the age of 26 years.

HERMANN-HODGE, GEORGE GUY

WINGFIELD ROAD

Royal Horse Artillery; Captain. France. Was placed in command of a Royal Field Artillery Battery at Trowbridge. He died of wounds received in action in the Battle of the Somme, 7th July, 1917. He was a fine horseman and a good shot, and very popular in Ireland where he did most of his service.

HILLMAN, EDWIN GEORGE

24 THOMAS STREET

R.F.A. Driver, France. Died of wounds received in action May 7th, 1917, at the age of 25 years.

26 NEWTOWN

R.F.A. Driver. Dardanelles and Mesopotamia. Died from wounds at Baghdad.

HOLLIS, EDWARD JOSEPH

WATERCRESS HOUSE FARLEY

Military Police; lance corporal, Home Service. Died at Chiseldon Military Hospital, November 16th, 1918.

HOLLOWAY, F.R.

HILPERTON MARSH

4th Wiltshire Regiment; Private; Home Service. Died of tuberculosis, June 21st, 1916

HOLLOWAY, JOB

22 TIMBRELL STREET

1st Wiltshire Regiment; Private, Mons Star. France. Killed July 15th, 1917

HOLLOWAY, WILLIAM JOHN

22, TIMBRELL STREET

4th 1st Wiltshire Regiment; Private, France. Enlisted in July, 1915 at the age of 16, and went to France in November. He was sent home in June 1916, owing to being underage, but was sent out in the following November and was wounded in the Battle of Messines on June 5th 1917. After recovery, he returned to the fighting line and was killed on March 23rd, 1918.

HOOPER, GEORGE

12 UPPER BOND STREET.

Welsh Regiment; Private, France. Killed January 23rd at Givenchy.

HORTON, HERBERT CLAUDE

112 MORTIMER STREET

2nd Wiltshire Regiment; Private; 1914-15 Star, France. Killed somewhere in France.

Somerset Light Infantry; Sergeant, France. Killed somewhere in France.

Royal Wilts Yeomanry; Trooper, France. Died of pneumonia, May 4th 1917 at St. Omar.

102 NEWTOWN

Wiltshire Regiment; Lance corporal; India and Egypt. Died of wounds in Egypt.

HURLEY, THOMAS

27 CASTLE STREET.

5th Wiltshire Regiment; Sergeant; Gallipoli, Egypt, and Mesopotamia. Killed April 9th, 1916, in relief of Kut.

HURN, HERBERT

1 MIDDLE RANK.

3rd Wiltshire Regiment, Private; Mons Star. France. Killed October, 1914.

Wiltshire Regiment, Lance Corporal. France. Killed March 10th, 1915, at Neuve Chappelle..
