Other Significant Information		
Arthur's birth was registered in the Melksham Registration District in the June Quarter of 1892		
On the 17th June 1914 Arthur William James Carr was born in Edington and baptised on the 12th July 1914. His mother was named as Alice Carr and no father was named in the register.		
Arthur married Alice Carr in Edington parish church on the 6th October 1916. Their son William James then took his father's surname		
The couple had a second son George Howard Isaac Lane born on the 18th July 1917 three months after his father had been killed.
