Reginald Walter Viney

Reginald Walter Viney was born in 1897. His birth was registered in December quarter in the district of Warminster, Wiltshire.

The 1901 England Census recorded Reginald W. Viney as a 3 year old, living with his family at 54 Bamforth Street, Nether Hallam, Sheffield, Yorkshire. His parents were recorded as George Viney (Railway Porter, aged 28, born Upton Lovell) & Lucy Viney (aged 26, born Cricklade). Also listed was Reginald's younger brother – Victor C. (aged 1, born Westbury).

The 1911 England Census recorded Reginald Walter Viney as a 13 year old Green grocer Errand Boy, living with his family at 59 Sherrington Road, Sheffield, Yorkshire – West Riding in a five roomed dwelling. His parents were recorded as George Viney (Police Constable, aged 39, born Upton Lovell) & Lucy Viney (aged 36, born Knook). Reginald was the eldest of 3 children listed on this census – Reginald, Victor Ernest Viney (at school, aged 11, born Westbury) & Doris Viney (aged 8, born Sheffield, Yorks).


Reginald W. Viney married Phoebe Gothard in 1920 in the district of Ecclesall Bierlow, West Riding of Yorkshire. The marriage was registered in the December quarter of 1920. Phoebe had been born in Sheffield, Yorkshire.

Reginald W. Viney, aged 23, & his wife Phoebe were listed as passengers on the *Empress of France* which had departed from Liverpool, England & arrived at the port of Quebec, Canada on 19 May, 1921.

The 1921 Census of Canada listed Reginald Viney, aged 23, & his wife Phoebe Viney, aged 22, as Lodgers at Mount Stephen House (Y.M.C.A.) in Field Village, Kootenay East, British Columbia. There were a total of 64 Lodgers listed. Reginald was listed as being a Labourer on Govt. Roads.

A death for a Phoebe Viney, aged 62, was registered in 1961 in Vancouver, British Columbia. She had died on 30 January, 1961.

A death for a Reginald Walter Viney, aged 79, was registered in 1977 at Kelowna, British Columbia. He had died on 26 July, 1977.
