Upton Lovell

The Living of Upton Lovell, near Warminster (to which the Rev. W. Gray was instituted last week), is of the annual value of 337 £. In 1794, the Rev. John Crouch, M.A., bequeathed 500 £ three percent. consols, the interest to be applied to the instruction of six poor children of the parish, in reading, writing, and the Church Catechism, during the week; and all such children as desire it in reading on the Sabbath.
