Inquests taken before Mr Coroner Sylvester –

At Upton Lovell, on Alice Augusta Oliver, aged two years. This child was playing with an elder sister on the banks of the river Wylde, which runs just opposite their parents' cottage, and fell into it. The current carried the body down the stream for a quarter of a mile. When taken out, life was extinct. There was an exposed opening opposite the cottage, at which spot they now intend erecting a gate.

Verdict, "Accidentally drowned."
