

Settlement Orders at Guildford, Surrey

22 July 1811

William Carr (signed his name). Trumpeter in His Majesty's 3rd Regt. Dragoons. Was born in Warminster, Wiltshire, received parish relief from that parish about three years ago. Wife Ann and Edward 16 months. *Source: Society of Genealogists SR/LOC B168*

10 May 1813

Richard Clarke (signed his name). Horsedealer. Holy Trinity, Guildford. About 16 years ago rented and occupied a house in Warminster, Wilts (£40 per annum). He then rented a house in St. George, Southwark, Surrey (£50) per annum, the address being No. 40 London Road, St. George's Fields, living there about a year. He then went to Holy Trinity, Guildford and rented a stable from Messrs. Winkworth and Cooper (5/0 weekly) and a furnished house from Mrs. Rivers (10/0 weekly). He never paid any rates or taxes on either property. Wife Ann. *Source: Society of Genealogists SR/LOC C45*

1 June 1819

Richard Clarke (signed his name). Horsedealer. Holy Trinity, Guildford. About 16 years ago rented and occupied a house in Warminster, Wilts (£40 per annum). Also he rented a stable belonging to Messrs. Winkworth Hooper (5/- weekly) and at the same time a furnished house in Holy Trinity, Guildford from Mrs. Rivers (10/- weekly) not paying rates or taxes. He has rented apartments in the house of George Bromley, Blessed Virgin Mary, Guildford (4/- weekly) and a stable from James Smart Holy Trinity, Guildford (£10 per annum).
