On Saturday, nine lads who were confined in the Reformatory near Warminster, succeed in making their escape. Inspector Bullock, of the Wilts Constabulary was informed of this fact; and, in the evening of that day, information reached him that five of the runaways had been seen on the Shaftsbury road. Subsequently they were seen walking through Mere by a young man of the place, who assisted the police in capturing them. They were locked up for the night, on Monday conveyed to the place they escaped from.
