This is the last Will and Testament of me Jane Dredge of Warminster in the County of Wilts Widow of Daniel Dredge made the Nineteenth day of December in the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and Seventy seven as follows (that is to say) I give and bequeath unto Mr Pittman Warren of Warminster in the County aforesaid Clothier and Mr Richard Randall of the same Place Clothier My Dwelling House and Garden thereto belonging which I hold by Lease under Mr Willm Bleek's (Late Jno Aldridge's) for all the Term or Terms Estate or Estates Interest and Interests that shall respectively be to come therein at the Time of my Decease I likewise give to the said Pittman Warren and Richard Randall all my Household Goods and wearing apparel whatsoever and wheresoever together with my Three Twisting Mills with all

the Necessaries thereto belonging Upon Trust that they my said Trustees or the Survivor of them may at my Decease sell or dispose of in the best Manner they shall think Proper for the Use of my Creditors and after all my Debts are paid together with my Funeral Expences what shall be left to be divided in Equal Shares for the Use of my Three Children (as My Trust shall think proper) and that they My Trustees shall be put to no Expence in and about the Execution of the Trust nor shall they be Answerable or Accountable for things unforeseen that shall happen nor shall one of them be Answerable for the Acts or Defaults or Neglects of the Other And whatever Expences about the Execution of this my last Will and Testament shall be paid and borne out of My Goods and Chattels or the Money arising therefrom In Witness whereof I have to this my said Last Will and Testament Set my hand and Seal
