


The Memorial Plaque of Judith Prater

South Transept of St. Mary's Church, West Kington

There is an effigy located in the wall of the chapel directly above Judith's tomb, which shows a full life size carving of Anthony, his coat-of-arms, his six children, and the following eulogy:



OH MI DEAR CHILDREN MARKE WHAT I SAYE,
