I Thomas Willett being weak in body but of a sound memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament I make my wife sole Executrix and I give to my wife the house and ye three halves now I live in during the life that is now upon it and all the household goods while she keep herself in my name and Afterwards to be divided amongst the children whereunto I set my hand Thomas Willett his mark

This will was proved at Sarum March 29th 1748 before the Revd John Nourse Master of Arts Lawfull Surrogate of the Revd Worshipfull Henry Stebbing Dr in Divinity Chancellor of the Diocese of Sarum and by him advised of the effects of the said Testator was granted to Margt Willett the Executrix being first sworn to the truth of the said will to perform the same and to exhibit a just and true account when lawfully required
