



Cruelty to a Horse – George Kill Westbury

Appeared in Salisbury and Winchester Journal 13th January 1872

George Kill of Westbury, was charged on the information of **Inspector Lascelles**, of Romsey, officer of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to animals, with working a horse in an unfit state at Westbury, on the 4th of August, and **Rachael Mead**, the owner of the animal, was summoned for causing the same to be worked whilst in an unfit state. -The defendants, who pleaded guilty were fined £1 pound and costs each.
