1837

Committed to Marlborough Bridewell John Stagg, for two months, for a trespass, at Wilcot. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 23 January 1837

1841

William Scott, convicted of breaking into the dwelling-house of Charles Dowse, at Wilcot, and stealing a pair of boots and various other articles, was sentenced to 18 month's hard labour. There was another indictment for burglary against the prisoner, but that was withdrawn.
