Salisbury Assizes. John Smith was indicted for breaking into the dwelling-house of John Brasher, at Ditchampton, and stealing therefrom sundry articles, his property, on the morning of the 10th of February; and William Rossiter was indicted for receiving the same, knowing them to have been stolen. The evidence being unsatisfactory, the prisoners were acquitted. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 14 March 1831**
