1868

Salisbury, Petty Sessions, Tuesday. William Wyatt, was charged with leaving his family chargeable to the Wilton Union. He had promised to pay 4s a week, and was ordered to make up the arrears, or go to gaol for a month. **Western Gazette**, **17 July 1868**

1870

Wilts Michaelmas Sessions Wednesday (Before Mr. Merewether, Q.C.) Jane Chalk, on bail, was indicted for obtaining drapery goods under false pretences, at Wilton, on the 5th February and 30th April last.
