Death of a Centenarian

Our obituary of this day contains an announcement of the death on Tuesday, at the Wilton Union Workhouse of Walter Hutchence, aged 103 years. The deceased retained the full possession of his mental faculties to the very last. He was somewhat eccentric in his manner and habits.

He formerly lived at Netherhampton, where he carried on the trade of a butter factor, attending Salisbury and Shaftesbury markets regularly.

He served his country as a soldier in the Wilts Militia during the American War in 1776 and following years.
