She was a true lover of the Church of England, And of all it's true and fincere Sons. She was Religious without affection, And without oftentation, generous &amp; free; Courteous, affable and obliging to all She converfed with; and compafionate and charitable to all that were difrefsed &amp; afflicted.</p> <p>And for a Memorial of Her; And Her Excellent qualities &amp; virtues George Baskerville of this Place, Gent. Baskerville	Thomas	Here Lyeth ye Body of THOMAS BASKERVILE of Richardston Esq. Who departed this Life Febr. 12 Anno 1756 who had 12 Sons
Cooper	Samuel	Here Lies the Body of SAMUEL COOPER Who died May 9 <sup>th</sup> 1748 Aged 60 Years Near this place alfo lieth Ann the Wife of Samuel Cooper who died 6 <sup>th</sup> Sep <sup>r</sup> 1754 Aged 66 Years
Marsh	Thomas	Here lyeth the Body of THOMAS MARSH Who died March 5 <sup>th</sup> 1742 Aged [?] Years
Wightwick	Martha	MARTHA Wife of William Wightwick D.D. Daughter of the Reverend Thomas Frampton Vicar of Broadhinton died July the 12 <sup>th</sup> 1749 in the 28 <sup>th</sup> Year of her Age William son of William and Martha Wightwick died October 1747 Aged 6 Months
Wightwick	William	The Reverend WILLIAM WIGHTWICK D.D. Rector of this Parifh died November the 30 <sup>th</sup> 1765 in the 64 <sup>th</sup> Year of his Age
