Who was during 46 Years Rector of this Parish He died March 16<sup>th</sup> 1815, aged 80 Years His remains were interred in Lyndhurst Church, in the County of Hants. Also to the Memory of Sarah Coleman his Wife daughter of the Rev<sup>d</sup>. John Woodyer, A.M. Rector of Lasham in the County of Hants. She died February 26<sup>th</sup> 1786; aged 52 Years Her remains were deposited at Andover in the same County In Te Deus, nostra est Spes.</p>
