BURBIDGE, EDWIN JOHN - Private 28150 - 1st Battalion Somerset Light Infantry - Died 15th April 1918 - age 19 - Born in Marston; Enlisted at Devizes; Son of Edwin John and Ellen Burbidge of The Close, Marston - Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Panels 38 & 39 - Commemorated on the Christchurch Roll of Honour Plaque, Worton - Commemorated on a private headstone in Christchurch Churchyard, Worton - Named in the Worton & Marston Section of the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

DUNFORD, HERBERT. A. - Private 18580 - 2nd Battalion Welsh Regiment - Died 26th September 1915 - Age 23 - Born in Worton; Resident of Worton; Enlisted at Cardiff, Glamorganshire; Son of Alfred and Mary Dunford of Worton - Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, Pas de Calais, France Grave/Memorial Reference:- Panels 77 & 78 - Commemorated on the Christchurch Roll of Honour Plaque, Worton - Named in the Worton & Marston Section of the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

FEW, HERBERT OWEN - Private 64448 - Durham Light Infantry attached to 3rd Company Labour Corps. - Died 11th August 1919 at home - Age 30 - Son of Stephen and Eliza Few of The Farm, Worton; Worked on the family farm. - Buried at Worton (Christ Church) Churchyard, Worton - Grave/Memorial Reference:- South West Part - Commemorated on the Christchurch Roll of Honour Plaque, Worton. - Named in the Worton & Marston Section of the Diocese of Salisbury Memorial Book, Salisbury Cathedral

HARRIS, HENRY FRANCIS - Shoeing Smith Corporal 5630 - 26th Veterinary Hospital, Royal Army Veterinary Corps - Died 14th January 1919 - Age 42 - Son of Thomas and Sarah Harris of Worton; Husband of Sarah Harris of Bray Street, Avebury - Buried at Alexandria (Hadra) War Memorial Cemetery, Egypt - Grave/Memorial Reference:- H. 92

KEARNS, GEORGE DAVID - Sergeant 8754 - 1st Battalion Leicestershire Regiment - Died 8th October 1916 of wounds - Age 25 - Born in Portsmouth, Hampshire; Resident of Kings Cross, London, Middlesex; Enlisted at Leicester, Leicestershire; Son of William and Eliza Kearns of Finsbury Park, London, Middlesex; Husband of M. G. Kearns, The Laurels, Worton - Buried at Etaples Military Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- XVI. E. 2A. - Named in the Leicestershire and Rutland Soldiers Who Died List 1914-1920.
