Whereas Roger Purches, late of Marston, in the parish of Potterne, near Devizes, now in Fisherton Anger gaol, prisoner for debt, has divers large debts owing to him, and has several quantities of wearing apparel, writings, and other things lying and detained at several houses at and near Devizes.

Those persons who are so indebted to him, or who have any of his effects, are desired to send the same to Fisherton gaol, and give him and his attorney a meeting, on or before the 28th of March inst. Otherwise they will be sued for the same, without further notice. He is directly removing to the King's Bench.
