### Construction company builds community links with Wornton and Marston village hall clean

THE village hall at Wornton and Marston, near Devizes, is looking spruce these days after staff from contractors Amey gave up their spare time to give it a facelift.

Eight members of staff from the firm's Swindon and Hampshire offices, which deliver everything from road building to aviation services, descended on the half-timbered hall last week.
