

Appeal for Return of Cart Horse

STOLEN or STRAYED, but supposed to be stolen, on Sunday night the 25th of June, 1780, out of a ground belonging to Blagrove Farm, in the parish of Wroughton, near Swindon, Wilts. - A BROWN MARE, of the Cart kind, ten or eleven years old, about sixteen hands high, very stout, with a large blaze down her face, a little white on the near foot before almost to the fetlock, the inside of the off leg behind white from the hoof up towards the hock, and never docked; and, on a nice examination, will be found to have had a fistula formerly.

Whoever will give intelligence of the said mare, so that she may be had again, to William Beames, the owner, at Blagrove aforesaid, or to Mr. Richard Farmer, at Swindon, shall receive Two Guineas reward, and all reasonable expences. [sic]
