This is the Last Will and Testament which is as follows to my dear Mother Diana Biggs of Stockton in the County of Wilts I leave all that I am worth in the world John Potticary Captain in the Army – December the 27 day in the Year of our Lord 1804 £500 in the 3 pr ct Consols and my Estate at Bapton *J Potticary*

It is also my Will that after the decease of my Mother D.B. that all my Personable Property shall be equally divided between the Children of my Brother William Potticary of Wylve deceased as they respectively come of Age and the Interest to be applied to their use Also I nominate W and D Davis Executors in Trust *Jno Potticary*

The above was wrote by me J Potticary the Sixteenth day of Decr 1805 before me *John Davis*
