Yatesbury

FIVE miles from Calne, Yatesbury is in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Union, Petty Sessional Division and County Court District of Calne and Diocese of Salisbury. The register of the Church of All Saints dates from 1607, and the living is a rectory, net value £325, with 12 acres of glebe. And residence. The area is 1,674 acres; rateable value, £1,499; population in 1921, 156. The trustees of the late Mr. C. Harris are the principal landowners. Letters arrive through Calne, and are despatched at 8.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. Postal orders are issued and paid here, and there is a Telegraph Office and Public Call Office.
