BLACKMAN, GEORGE - Private 9086 - A Company, 1st Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 18th October 1914 - Age 19 - Born in Yatton Keynell; Resident of Trowbridge; Enlisted at Devizes; Son of Mr. and Mrs. H. Blackman of From Road, Southwick, North Bradley - Commemorated on the Le Touret Memorial, Pas de Calais, Nord, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Panel 33 and 34.

COLES, C. E. - Private 140532 - 1st (Reserve) Battalion, Canadian Infantry - Died 21st October 1918 - Age 42 - Son of Mrs. Julia Coles of Lanhill Cottages, Yatton Keynell - Buried at North Wraxall (St. James) Churchyard, North Wraxall - Grave/Memorial Reference:- None Recorded - Headstone Inscription reads:- "Thy Will Be Done".

GREENMAN, EDWARD JAMES - Lance Corporal 15034 - 7th Battalion, Royal Dublin Fusiliers - Died 16th September 1915 of wounds at Gallipoli - Age 21 - Born in Yatton Keynell; Enlisted at Chippenham; Son of the late George Greenman and Mary Snell (formerly Greenman) of Yatton Keynell, Wiltshire; Awarded Victory Medal, and 1915 Star - Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Sedd el Bahr, Turkey - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Panel 190 to 196 - Commemorated on the Roll of Honour Plaque In St. Margaret's Church, Yatton Keynell.

SNELL, MONTAGUE DOUGLAS - Private 10800 - 5th Battalion, Wiltshire Regiment - Died 10th August 1915 - Age 19 - Born in Yatton Keynell in 1895; Resident of Yatton Keynell; Enlisted at Devizes; Son of Emmanuel and Georgina Snell of Yatton Keynell; Awarded Victory Medal, British Medal & 1915 Star - Buried at No. 2 Outpost Cemetery, Turkey - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Sp. Mem. 45. - Commemorated on the Roll of Honour Plaque In St. Margaret's Church, Yatton Keynell.

SNELL, THOMAS PERCY - Gunner 61758 - B Battery, 51st Brigade, Royal Field Artillery - Died 8th July 1916 of wounds - Age 37 - Born in Corsham in 1879; Resident of Yatton Keynell; Enlisted at Devizes; Son of William and Agnes Snell of Yatton Keynell; Awarded Victory Medal, British Medal & 1915 Star - Buried at Dantzig Alley British Cemetery, Mametz, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - IX. U. 4 - Commemorated on the Roll of Honour Plaque in St. Margaret's Church, Yatton Keynell.

TUCK, ERNEST WILFRED - Private 8146 - 2nd Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 24th October 1914 - Born in Castle Combe; Resident of Castle Combe; Enlisted at Devizes; Awarded Victory & British Medals and 1914 & Clasp - Commemorated on Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, West-

Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial reference - Panel 53 - Commemorated on the Roll of Honour
Plaque In St. . Margaret's Church, Yatton Keynell.
