This is the last Will and Testament of me Elizabeth Hooper, the wife of the Reverend Thomas Hooper of Yatton Keynell in the county of Wiltshire (late Elizabeth Butler, Spinster), whereas under the last Will and Testament of my late father John Butler, I am empowered in case I shall not have any child ... who shall live to attain the age of twenty one years by any good or instrument in writing or by my last will and testament or any codicil thereto to be cooperatively executed by ... in the presence of and attested by two or more witnesses ... to appoint one moiety or half part of the sum of one thousand pounds in the said will mentioned and of all accumulations thereof ... I appoint the said Thomas Hooper, his executors administrators and assigns and I hereby appoint him the said Thomas Hooper sole Executor of this my will. I have hereunto set my seal this twenty seventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five. Signed, *Elizabeth Hooper* as her last will and testament in the presence of Thomas Hooper, husband, Rector of Yatton Keynell and Elizabeth Hooper, his wife.
